- 1. Lyric poetry is a form of expressing strong feelings. What two strong feelings does the first stanza suggest?
- 2. Why is the speaker offering the poem?
- 3. What does the speaker want the person he is addressing to remember?

"It's Raining in Love" (Elements, p. 251)

- 4. To what is the speaker referring when he says, "I don't say the right things / or perhaps I start / to examine, evaluate, compute what I am saying"?
- 5. Why does the speaker say he gets "a little creepy"?
- 6. Why does the speaker mention the "clear blue California sky"?

"Heart! We will forget him!" (Elements, p. 487)

- 7. Who is the speaker of Dickinson's poem, and whom is the speaker talking to?
- 8. Dickinson personifies her heart by telling it to do things that only a person can do. What does she tell her heart? What does she mean by "warmth" and "light"?
- 9. What does the speaker in the poem want to do?

"The Flying Cat" (Elements, p. 514)

- 10. Free Verse: How does the first stanza differ from the second structurally?
